How Can You Help?

- **Fence or board properties which might attract trespassers or vandals.**
- **Keep grounds and structures clean and tidy.**
- **Park in designated parking areas.**
- **Learn and adhere to local zoning and code regulations.**
- **Do not tolerate illicit activity.**
- **Cooperate in good faith should you receive a complaint.**
- **Report violations and nuisances.**

Common Hazards & Nuisances

- Abandoned or illegally parked vehicles
- Excessive animals
- Illegal home-based businesses
- Noncompliance with personal, minor auto repair standards at a residence
- Excessive noise
- More than three two-day yard sales per year
- Substandard building or housing conditions
- Unsanitary or unsafe places
- Rodent or insect infestations
- Commercial vehicles in a residential zone
- Illegally occupied or parked motor homes, automobiles, trailers, or mobile homes
- Junk, Garbage, & Rubbish
- Illegal Signs

Enforcement



Code Enforcement encourages compliance. In most cases, the person responsible for the code violation will be given an opportunity to correct the problem. If the problem is not resolved, further action may be taken, including court action.
